

IMPROVEMENT ZONE 1:

Critical Preservation Recommendations

- 1. Restore and clean broken obelisk
- 2. Restore broken fencing at Howe Family Lot
- * 3. Restore eroded earth mound at "floating" obelisk.
- *4. Repair and repoint stone wall; remove volunteer vegetation impacting wall.



IMPROVEMENT ZONE 1:

Landscape Recommendations

- 1. Create a more welcoming main entrance: repair gate (in progress), create special paving zone with interpretive signage.
- *2. Improve the landscape along the stone wall: provide pea-stone shoulders and plant ornamental planting at entrances in collaboration w/ Civic Pride

IMPROVEMENT ZONE 1:

Landscape Issues and Recommendations



Existing: Path at west Village Ave entry



Proposed: Resurface path with stabilized stone surfacing

Existing: Edge at St. Paul's Church



Proposed: Formalize edge with chain between the granite posts

IMPROVEMENT ZONE 1:

Landscape Recommendations (cont.)

- 3. Reactivate the west Village Ave. Entrance: create a resurfaced pedestrian path at former gravel drive
- *4. Create a pedestrian side entrance from sidewalk at St. Paul's Church; formalize the edge with steel chain between historic granite posts.

IMPROVEMENT ZONES 2a AND 2b

Critical Preservation Recommendations:

- * 1. Remove volunteer vegetation impacting granite tomb row.
- * 2. Repair segments of failed stone wall; remove volunteer trees and stumps impacting wall; repoint as needed.
- *3. Replenish and stabilize eroded soil to prevent coping collapse.
 - 4. Repair failed stone copings that impact visitor safety.
 - 5. Remove trees impacting monuments where practicable.

IMPROVEMENT ZONES 2

Critical Preservation Issues and Recommendations



Existing: Eroding steep slope at tomb row



Proposed: Create slope stabilization planting



Existing: Routed main path



Proposed: Repair main path with reinforced turf or stabilized stone surfacing



Existing: lot enclosures difficult to mow



Proposed: Revegetation of select lots with low-maintenance ground covers

IMPROVEMENT ZONE 2a


Landscape Recommendations:

- 1. Create attractive slope stabilization planting near granite tomb row.
- 2. Repair routed driveway with reinforced turf or stabilized stone surfacing.
- 3. Implement careful supplemental revegetation in select plots.

Proposed: Ornamental rain garden planting



Landscape Recommendations

- 4. Provide new fence and pedestrian entrance at Martin Bates Street.
- 5. Rehabilitate poorly drained area along Bates St with ornamental rain garden.

IMPROVEMENT ZONE 3 Landscape Recommendations:

- 1. Replace chain link fencing with granite post and chain. Provide a secondary entrance from parking for community access and service.
- 2. Create a landscape buffer along parking lot frontage, creating a serene landscape area.
